Breaking Boundaries // 2019 Snowboard, Freestyle and Freeski World Champs Youth Film Contest

The Park City Summit County Arts Council (PCSC Arts Council), the Park City Film Series, and U.S. Ski & Snowboard (collectively known as “the Partners”) have partnered to present the Breaking Boundaries // 2019 Snowboard, Freestyle and Freeski World Champs Youth Film Contest. We are looking for young filmmakers (21 and under) to tell stories about breaking boundaries. In the world of elite competitive snowboarding, freestyle and free skiing, athletes challenge themselves to push the boundaries of creativity and difficulty to be the best in the world in these sports. The best in the world challenge the expectations of what is possible.

We are asking these filmmakers to tell stories of breaking boundaries in their community. These stories do not necessarily need to be about skiing or snowboarding or competitive sport, rather we are looking for stories that will inspire the community and the athletes of the 2019 FIS World Championships.

All entries will be posted to the Breaking Boundaries // 2019 Snowboard, Freestyle and Freeski World Champs Youth Film Contest Vimeo Group (<https://vimeo.com/groups/510639>) and fill out the submission form with your full name, date of birth, address, description of the piece along with your Breaking Boundaries story.

All entries must be appropriate for all audiences. Films referencing sex, drugs, or violence will not be accepted as entries. Any film that includes content that is deemed inappropriate, indecent and/or obscene, as determined by the Partners in their collective or individual discretion, will not be eligible. Contestants must be residents of Salt Lake, Wasatch or Summit County, Utah, at the time of submission, and must be 21 years of age or younger.

Entrants represent and warrant that (i) the films that they submit: are their own original creations and do not infringe on any other person's or entity's rights; (ii) they have obtained permission, if applicable, from the people featured in the film to enter this Contest; and (iii) the submission of the idea will not violate any enforceable agreements or understandings the entrant has with any third party. Submissions may, for the purposes of this contest, have been previously entered into a film competition.

Entrants can submit as many videos as you would like. Submissions must be in English or

subtitled in English. Videos shall be no more than 10 minutes. Each video must be submitted in the name of one, and only one, entrant. However, submissions may be the work of a team consisting of residents of Salt Lake, Wasatch or Summit County provided all members of that team are 21 years of age or younger.

Entering the Breaking Boundaries // 2019 Snowboard, Freestyle and Freeski World Champs Youth Film Contest grants the Partners the right to contact the entrant regarding their submission, publicize their entry, broadcast their submission, and/or otherwise promote their entry for any other purpose related to the Contest.

Grant of Rights in Films Submitted

Submission of a film constitutes the irrevocable right to Breaking Boundaries // 2019 Snowboard, Freestyle and Freeski World Champs Youth Film Contest of all rights in the film, all rights to use all or any portion of the film, to copy, sublicense, edit, modify, make derivative works, publish, exploit, transmit, distribute, publicly perform, publish, delete or display the content of and any elements embodied in the Film and the Film itself, in whole or in part, in perpetuity in any and all media (whether now existing or hereafter devised) without limitation, and without consideration or acknowledgment to the entrant and the unconditional right to use the idea and statements about the film or all or any portion of the film itself for advertising/publicity purposes without additional compensation, except where prohibited by law.

Once submitted, films may not be broadcast on any public platforms other than the Breaking Boundaries // 2019 Snowboard, Freestyle and Freeski World Champs Youth Film Contest Vimeo Group (<https://vimeo.com/groups/510639>). Entries shall remain private until the winners are announced.

Review panel and selection criteria

Winners will be selected by a panel of judges. The judging panel will be comprised of the Partners, local freestyle/freeski athletes and other leaders in the visual arts and film community.

The Partners reserve the right to assemble a pre-screening panel to narrow the number of films to be reviewed by the judging panel. The same criteria will be used whether the submission is reviewed by a judging panel or a pre-screening panel. Panelists will select films that are the most inspiring, pragmatic, and compelling, although, at the sole discretion of The Partners such criteria may not be given equal weight.

CONTEST PRIZES

Winner:

- Cash Prize of \$2,500
- 1 Month exclusive experience embedded with U.S. Ski & Snowboard's content department for the 2019 World Championships. Working with both their in-house content team as well as their host broadcaster feature team capturing behind the scenes stories of the Event.
- Media/Broadcast accreditation for the event including lift access for the Event
- Organizing Committee team uniform (Jacket/hat etc.)

Runner up:

- Cash Prize of \$500
- 2 VIP tickets for up to 4 event competition finals for the Championships

Winner will receive written prize notice via email on October 1, 2018 and by phone on October 7, 2018 if winners are not reachable via email. If an entrant cannot be reached by phone within ten (10) business days, the prizes may be forfeited and the next successful entrant will receive said prizes.

Delivery of Prizes

To be determined based on prize awarded. The Partners reserve the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. Prizes are non-transferable, assignable or redeemable for cash (if applicable).

THE FINE PRINT

Use of Winners' Names and Likeness

Each winner who accepts any prize will be deemed thereby to have granted to the Partners the right, at any time and from time to time, to print, publish, broadcast and use, worldwide and in any media now known or hereafter developed, including but not limited to, the Internet and world wide web, the name, portrait, picture, voice, likeness and biographical information of each such winner as news or information and for advertising and promotional purposes without additional consideration, except where prohibited by law.

Disqualification

The Partners reserve the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any participant that it determines is ineligible to participate in the Contest. Failure to comply with these rules may also result in a participant's disqualification.

Limitation of Liability

If, for any reason, the Contest is not capable of running as planned, due to but not limited to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other cause which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of this Contest, the Partners reserve the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Contest. The Partners further reserve the right, at their sole discretion, to disqualify any individual who tampers, in any way, with the Contest. The Partners assume no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries. Jurisdiction; Venue²

Any dispute that may arise hereunder, if not settled by the parties directly or through alternate dispute resolution, shall be brought solely in the appropriate state or federal court sitting in Utah. Participants consent to the personal jurisdiction and venue thereof. The prevailing party shall be entitled to an award of costs incurred including attorney fees.
